- Shakira Johnson, Assistant Educator and Oral Historian
 - Tells her story that she grew up in Public Housing and now works for the Public Housing Museum.
- Mark Jaeschke, Oral History and Program Coordinator
 - Mark plays a segment from Spotify "Out of the Archives" as a resident from Cabrini gives a recorded first hand account, about her childhood in the row houses and how she leaves Cabrini in 1967 for a new neighborhood.
