## Revolution Workshop

- Patti Delgado, Community Outreach Coordinator
- Non profit Construction training. Entry level. This is a Pre-apprenticeship program
- In business for 4 years located at 3410 W Lake. Working to get a second location in Pullman.
- To work individuals need a social security card, all eventually need to get a driver's license. Will work with individuals that need help getting a license.
- Background friendly. Will work with non violent past offenders. There is work simulated trainings.
- 12 week program M-F 8 am to 4 pm to simulate real world expectations of employment. There is a probationary period of 2 weeks.
- Gain entry level skills in carpentry and woodworking. Painting, plumbing, and electric people are connected to these trades as well.
- Will also provide life skills like Finance literacy, executive functioning, Credit information, and Job Interviewing skills.

- Receive stipend while in training \$50, Ventra and/or Gas cards for transportation, tutoring, set up with tools.
- Process is to attend Virtual info sessions, apply, interview, go to orientation, then get a training start date..
