- Lakesia Collins, Illinois 9th District
 - Discusses the recently passed Illinois State budget.
 - Green Construction items in the budget 195 million.
 - Replace lead water service lines 113 million
 - Public Safety 124 million to local Police for mental health, retention grant, witness protection, trauma recovery, vests, Youth Build Illinois
 - Financial Relief 1.0 billion
 - Education Pk-12 350 million for evidence based education funding, special education, education grants, training teachers, early childhood education, 5% to Higher education funding
 - Pension fund pay down unpaid bills 9.6 million.
 - 130 million for legal assistance for those facing eviction.
 - Health Care 180 million- reform bill where the Federal Government ties funding to bedside care in nursing homes. 20 million for public health preparedness
 - Governor Suspend food tax, freeze gas tax, double property tax rebate and sales tax holiday for buying school supplies.

 - 1601 N Cark open Tuesday Sunday 9:30 -4:30.
 - Presentation of facts and visuals that show the work and life narrative of these five African American designers that influenced life in Chicago.

- Bally's (Proposed Casino Tribune Site)
 - Ameet Patel, VP and Regional General Manager, West
 - Christopher Jewett, VP of Corporate Development
 - Bally's started in Chicago as a Pinball machine manufacturer.
 - Repurpose the unused Tribune 700 W Chicago as the temporary Casino. It will take one year or less to build.
 - Ballys has 16 Casinos.
 - Discuss traffic study. Community voices concerns about increase in traffic. Discuss comparison to current traffic from approved PD for the Tribune site. Details at https://www.ballys.com/chicago/tribune-project.htm
 - Permanent facility will take three years to build. Will have 500 slots, 40 tables, 3000 car parking on site, rooftop bar, comedy club
 - Hiring 60% minority, 45% women, 5% vet, 5% disabled
 - 15,000 jobs construction and 2000 permanent jobs
 - Bally's will do an agreement with the union.
 - Minority contractor to build Casino.
