 - There is a New City Safety Coordination Center launched last year.
 - Whole government approach. Look at data from safety, public health, social services, Police

 - \$100/lights, max \$200/residence, exterior outdoor motion sensor

 - Connects with app, Max 2 cars, Summer 2022
 - \$50/device, \$120/subscription, residents only
